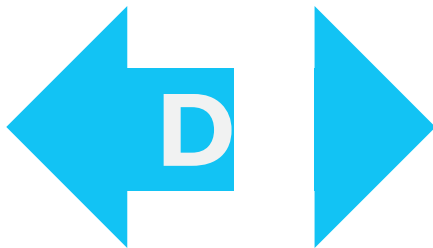

Speak

-  To the family - have a conversation with them
-  To professionals in your network - e.g. a Duty Family Support Worker



-  Use available online resources and signpost to services
-  Complete the Pathway to change planning tool with the family
-  Signpost the family to the Family Information Service / local Family Support Worker / Children and Family Centre / Drop in service and duty phone line
-  Refer a family to the Front Door only if there is an immediate safeguarding concern
