Warwickshire Safeguarding Partnership publication of Child Safeguarding Practice Review

Warwickshire's Safeguarding Partnership has today (Tuesday 5th October 2021) published the findings of a Child Safeguarding Practice Review into the sad death of Jack.

Elaine Coleridge Smith, Independent Chair of Warwickshire Safeguarding Partnership said:

“Warwickshire's Safeguarding Partnership would like to express its condolences to the family of Jack who tragically took his own life last year. There was minimal involvement from agencies leading up to his death though the circumstances at the time were extraordinary. The COVID-19 pandemic and the nation's response to meant young people were away from school, support networks and usual routines which was incredibly hard, and for Jack a devastating loss of life.

“Warwickshire's Safeguarding Partnership has conducted a Child Safeguarding Practice Review on this case as an opportunity for agencies to come together to reflect on what happened and what more can be done to continually improve practice to safeguard young people.”
