
Honour based violence is a crime

Could you recognise the signs?

Honour based violence (HBV) is a violent crime or incident which may have been committed to protect or defend the honour of the family or community. Signs may include:

- being withdrawn from education by those with parental responsibility
- unreasonable personal restrictions, e.g. 'house arrest'
- a combination of many other factors
